TODAY 'S GOSPEL – In today's gospel Jesus calls two sets of brothers to follow him. They were all fishermen and Jesus told them that he would make them fishers of people. Jesus wants us to be fishers of people too, to bring others to him.

NEXT SUNDAY - February 2nd we will go back to the time when Jesus was a baby and forty days old. This will be the feast of the **Presentation of the Lord** in the temple which was required by the Jewish law. This feast is also called Candlemas when candles are often blessed. Father Matthew will be blessing candles for you to take home. This feast is also called the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Mary did not really need purification because she was conceived without sin as the future mother of Jesus, who is the Son of God. But they were obeying the Jewish law that a woman needed to be purified 40 days after the birth of a son.
